





PLACE: Tensy-Dome, Villa dei Cedri Park, Bellinzona

DESCRIPTION

A structure designed by the architect Filippo Broggini in 2016 stands in the Villa dei Cedri Park, next to the Italian garden. Commissioned and financed by the Friends of the Villa dei Cedri Foundation, the primary function of this new architectonic shape is to host attendees, but it is also an object that highlights the green spaces of the park.

In its naturalistic and cultural context, the pavilion comprises a network of structural branches – ready to be covered with foliage (but replaced in this project by a roofing membrane) – and rests on a reinforced concrete foundation lined with granite slabs. For conferences and/or concerts, no sound amplification is required. The Tensy-Dome is equipped with LED lighting and natural ventilation outlets with warm air extractors. There is no heating and/or air conditioning. The entrance/exit zones give direct access to the pathways in the park.

A venue designed and conceived for people who wish to organise an event in contact with nature, but at the same time in an innovative and artistic space. Suitable for conferences and private events, such as drinks and standing dinners or concerts.

APERO

You will have an opportunity to serve an *apero* to your guests. You can choose between service on arrival or at the end of the conference. Depending on your budget, a suitable proposal will be made: simple finger food with Museum wines or a more copious offering with service.
